
SUMMARY-

Major construction activity is winding down on the Mill Plain corridor, with structural work on platforms and sidewalks largely complete at most station locations. Crews have shifted their focus to smaller elements of each future Vine station, including windscreens, railings, roofing and technology. Fiber and utility work continues along the entire project corridor. Workers are

also making rapid progress at the new Mill Plain Transit Center, located near Mill Plain and 184th Avenue.

MILESTONES—

In May, crews installed the final two shelter structures on the corridor, meaning all 37 new station locations now have shelters



in place. At Mill Plain Transit Center, large concrete pours have begun to form the main busway at the facility, as well as the transit center platform. On the west side of the corridor, workers continued to install red shelter "icons" that identify each station location, plus utilities and other technology components.

Mill Plain BRT is the second branch of The Vine, C-TRAN's bus rapid transit service. The new segment
